


February 2015 in Europe





Στις 20 Φεβρουαρίου έγινε ο αποκριάτικος χορός στο σχολείο μας. Όλα τα παιδιά ντυθήκαμε καρναβάλια και χορέψαμε πάρα πολύ. Νεράιδες, πριγκίπισσες, νιτζα και Μαξτιν ήταν οι στολές που κυριαρχούσαν.

Το πιο συναρπαστικό ήταν ότι η τάξη μας χόρεψε γαϊτανάκι και μας θαύμασε όλο το σχολείο. Είναι ένα παλιό αποκριάτικο έθιμο, όπου ο κυκλικός χορός υποδηλώνει τον κύκλο της ζωής, από τη χαρά στη λύπη, από το Χειμώνα στην Άνοιξη, από τη ζωή στο θάνατο και το αντίθετο.


Χόρεψε και η κυρία μαζί μας. Δεκατρία άτομα χρειάζονται για να στήσουν το χορό. Ο ένας κρατά ένα μεγάλο στύλο στο κέντρο, από την κορυφή του οποίου ξεκινούν 12 μακριές κορδέλες, καθεμιά με διαφορετικό χρώμα. Οι κορδέλες αυτές λέγονται γαϊτάνια και δίνουν το όνομά τους στο έθιμο. Γύρω από το στύλο, 12 χορευτές κρατούν από ένα γαϊτάνι και χορεύουν μαζί, σε 6 ζευγάρια, τραγουδώντας το παραδοσιακό τραγούδι.

Καθώς κινούνται γύρω από το στύλο, κάθε χορευτής εναλλάσσεται με το ταίρι του κι έτσι όπως γυρνούν πλέκουν τις κορδέλες γύρω από το στύλο δημιουργώντας χρωματιστούς συνδυασμούς.

Στη συνέχεια ζωγραφίσαμε την Κυρά Σαρακοστή με τα εφτά πόδια. Μετά τις απόκριες την άλλη μέρα ξεκινάει η νηστεία για 7 εβδομάδες μέχρι το Πάσχα. Κάθε εβδομάδα θα κόβουμε ένα πόδι της Σαρακοστής για να δούμε πόσες εβδομάδες μας έχουν μείνει. Το τελευταίο πόδι το κόβουμε το μεγάλο Σάββατο της Ανάστασης.

Τσικνοπέμπτη στο Μάνδαλο

Την Τσικνοπέμπτη στο χωριό μας γίνεται μεγάλη γιορτή. Είναι η τελευταία μέρα που τρώμε κρέας γιατί θα ξεκινήσει η νηστεία. Γιορτάζεται 11 μέρες πριν την Καθαρά Δευτέρα. Φέτος ήταν στις 12 Φεβρουαρίου.

Σε κάθε γειτονιά ψήνονται σουβλάκια και χορεύουμε πολύ. Πιατέλες με κρέατα πηγαίνουν σε όλα τα σπίτια για να υπάρχει η μυρωδιά του κρέατος. Το χαμόγελο και η παραδοσιακή μουσική κυριαρχεί. Ζητάμε συγχώρεση από αυτούς που πληγώσαμε και ντυνόμαστε καρναβάλια που υποτίθεται ότι διώχνουν τα κακά πνεύματα του χειμώνα και βοηθάμε έτσι στην εξασφάλιση μιας επιτυχημένης σοδειάς.

Πατρινό Καρναβάλι

Το Πατρινό καρναβάλι είναι η μεγαλύτερη αποκριάτικη εκδήλωση στην Ελλάδα. Μετρά 180 χρόνια ιστορίας. Το καρναβάλι της Πάτρας δεν είναι μόνο μια συγκεκριμένη εκδήλωση αλλά ένα σύνολο εκδηλώσεων που περιλαμβάνουν χορούς, παρελάσεις, κυνήγι κρυμμένου θησαυρού, καρναβάλι των μικρών. Κορυφώνεται την τελευταία Κυριακή των Αποκριών. Φέτος 35.000 καρναβαλιστές σε 141 γκρουπ πήραν μέρος και δεν πτοήθηκαν από τη βροχή. Οι στολές τους φαντασμαγορικές καθώς προετοιμάζονται ένα χρόνο πιο μπροστά. Τα άρματα με το βασιλιά καρνάβαλο και τη βασίλισσα πολύ εντυπωσιακά. Το κέφι απερίγραπτο. Είμαστε ένας λαός που το χαμόγελο δε φεύγει από τα χείλη μας και είχαμε την ανάγκη μέσω του καρναβαλιού να σατιρίσουμε καθετί παράξενο. Ακόμη και με την οικονομική κρίση, ο Έλληνας δε χάνει τη ζωντάνια του.

The carnival ball

On the 20th of February, a carnival ball took place at our school. All the children dressed up and we danced a lot. Ferries, princesses, ninjas and Maxtin were the predominant costumes.

The most exciting part was when our class danced around a maypole and the whole school admired us. It is an old carnival custom where the circular dance suggests the circle of life from happiness to sadness, from winter to spring, from life to death and the opposite.

Our teacher danced with us too. Thirteen people are required to start the dance. One of them is holding a big pole in the centre, at the top of which 12 long ribbons are tied, each one of a different colour. These ribbons are called gaitania and this custom takes its name from them. Around the pole, 12 dancers are holding a ribbon each and they dance together, in 6 couples, singing a traditional song.

As they chase each other around the pole, each dancer changes place with their partner and as they move around they weave the ribbons around the pole creating, this way, colourful combinations.

After that we painted Mrs Lent with seven legs. The next day after the carnival people start fasting for seven weeks until Easter. Every week we will cut one of Mrs Lent's legs to show how many weeks are left. We cut the last leg on Saturday before Easter Sunday.

Shrove Thursday in Mandalo

On Shrove Thursday there is a big celebration in our village. It is the last day we eat meat because people will begin fasting. It is celebrated 11 days before the beginning of the lent. This year it took place on the 12th of February.

In every neighbourhood they bake meat on a skewer and we dance a lot. Platters with meat are taken to every house so that there is the smell of meat. Smiles and traditional music are dominant. We ask for forgiveness from those we hurt and we dress up in costumes which are supposed to send away the bad spirits of winter and in that way we help to ensure a successful harvest.

The carnival in Patras

The carnival in Patras is the biggest carnival festival in Greece. It has a history of 180 years. The carnival in Patras is not only one specific festivity but a series of festivities which include dancing, parades, treasure hunt, kid's carnival. It reaches its peak on the last Sunday of the carnival. This year 35.000 people in 141 groups took part and they were not daunted by rain. Their costumes were fantastic since they prepare for it a year in advance. The floats with the king of carnival and the queen are very impressive. The fun is indescribable. We are people whose smile never leaves our lips and we felt the need to satirize everything strange. Even with the economical crisis, Greeks don't lose their liveliness.


Il giorno 3 febbraio è stato eletto il nuovo presidente della Repubblica Italiana SERGIO MATTARELLA.

Giorgio De Chirico "Gioco e Gioia della neometafisica".

Abbiamo raggiunto Campobasso da Ripalimosani con lo scuolabus con le nostre insegnanti. C'era ad attenderci una guida molto brava, che ha ci ha spiegato i quadri lungo il percorso museale.

La mostra comprende 68 opere della collezione Fondazione Giorgio De Chirico e Isa De Chirico con dipinti, disegni e litografie. E' una delle mostre più complete dell'artista.

La mostra riguarda gli ultimi dieci anni della produzione dell'artista De Chirico, cioè il periodo della neometafisica.

La neometafisica rappresenta la visione ironica e giocosa del suo mondo immaginario. In quel periodo della sua vita artistica De Chirico ha utilizzato colori brillanti.

Nelle sue opere sono rappresentati: i manichini, l'arte greca, gli spazi teatrali, gli strumenti del suo lavoro, le finestre e le porte aperte, le piazze, ma mai le persone.

Giorgio De Chirico nasce il 10 luglio 1888 a Volos, in Grecia; suo padre era italiano. Ha viaggiato per il mondo: Germania, Francia, Usa e Italia. Lui incontrò molti artisti come Carrà, Picasso, Nietzsche.

Nella sua vita ha scritto molti libri, ha realizzato sculture, molti dipinti e disegni.

Il 20 novembre 1978, Giorgio De Chirico muore a Roma a 90 anni.

A noi è piaciuto molto il quadro intitolato: "Il Ritorno di Ulisse". Infatti a scuola lo abbiamo dipinto.

L'artista diceva: "La mia stanza è una bella nave dove posso fare viaggi avventurosi".

Nella foto c'è un mare metafisico. Il vero viaggio, per lui, è un tour interiore, attraverso la sua arte.

Questo lavoro rappresenta il ritorno di Ulisse in Grecia e quindi il suo ritorno in Grecia dove è nato.

Questa esperienza è stata fantastica per noi.

Our fantastic experience: Giorgio De Chirico exhibition .

On the 24th of February, the fifth class visited De Chirico exhibition: Giorgio De Chirico "Gioco e Gioia della neometafisica".

We reached to Campobasso by schoolbus with our teachers.

There was a very good guide, who explained the paintings along the museum. The exhibition, 68 works from the Fondazione Giorgio De Chirico e Isa De Chirico included paintings, drawings and lithographs. It represents one of the most complete exhibition of the artist .

The exhibition is about the last 10 years of the De Chirico's artist production: the Neometaphysical period. Neometaphysical represents the playful ironic and lucid vision of his own imaginative world. In this paintings De Chirico used the brilliant colours.

In his works he represented dummies, Greek art, the marqueead theatre, the work tools, the opened windows and door, the squares and never people.

Giorgio De Chirico was born on the 10th of July, in 1888, in Volos, Greece; his parents were Italian. He travelled in all part of the world: Germany, France, Usa, and Italy. He met many artists: Carrà , Picasso, Nietzsche. In his life he wrote many books, he realized sculptures, many pictures and drawings.

On the 20th of November, in 1978 ,Giorgio De Chirico died in Rome at 90 years of age.


We liked "Il Ritorno di Ulisse" very much. At school draw and painted this work. He said: "My room is a beautiful ship where I can do adventure travel".

Diversi musicisti con chitarre, mandolini e alcuni strumenti a percussione come il "Bufu", accompagnano i canti. Gli spettatori per tradizione accompagnano la Mascherata nelle varie "Posate" dalle ore 12:00 fino alla sera, divertendosi insieme ai protagonisti.

La Mascherata di questo anno dal titolo "Ieri, oggi e domani", ha coinvolto circa 70 persone, dei quali la maggior parte giovani del posto. Quest'anno la Mascherata non aveva un filo conduttore, ma è stata un revival delle precedenti dagli anni 70' agli anni 90', con lo scopo di far conoscere alle nuove generazioni i canti di una volta. Le scenette invece scritte ex-novo permettevano di cogliere il legame tra il passato e il presente.

L'ultima posata, che si è svolta nel teatro comunale, ha visto la partecipazioni di 1000 spettatori tra ripesi e non. Collegati in streaming, c'erano 1200 spettatori da tutte le parti del mondo, per consentire soprattutto agli emigranti di partecipare a questo evento così sentito da tutti i ripesi.

E' stato un grande successo di pubblico per la soddisfazione di tutti gli organizzatori e di tutti coloro che sono stati coinvolti in questa tradizionale manifestazione.

Nessuna zona del centro è stata risparmiata dagli hooligans, da Campo de' Fiori al Pincio, allo Stadio Olimpico, ma è il cuore della Capitale ad essere stato ferito.

La sera del 18 febbraio già un nutrito gruppo di tifosi ubriachi aveva messo a soqquadro il centro di Roma: lanci di bottiglie, segnali stradali divelti, motorini ed auto danneggiati. Nonostante ci fosse il divieto di vendere alcolici in centro, gli hooligans si sono riforniti dai venditori ambulanti abusivi.

Il giorno successivo, attraverso i social network, si sono dati appuntamento al centro di Roma ed è lì che è cominciata la guerriglia urbana: vetrine rotte, macchine danneggiate, strade piene di sporcizia, ma soprattutto panico tra residenti e turisti, costretti a scappare.

La polizia è intervenuta spingendo gli hooligans impazziti, armati di bastoni e coltelli, verso Piazza di Spagna. Qui è avvenuto lo scontro tra la polizia e i tifosi, armati anche di bombe carta, con il lancio di fumogeni e lacrimogeni per disperderli. Questi tifosi, nel frattempo, hanno usato la fontana "BARCACCIA" come un bersaglio da colpire con le bottiglie, come discarica e urinatoio. Sono state individuate 110 scalpitture di bottiglie e petardi. Un frammento di travertino di 10 cm si è staccato; queste sono le ferite inferte ad un simbolo storico della città. La fontana era stata appena restaurata con un costo di 200.000,00 euro. Nel frattempo sono stati arrestati 23 tifosi olandesi e 25 sono stati denunciati. Durante la rissa sono stati feriti 31 agenti e 9 carabinieri. Nonostante tutto la Polizia olandese non ha voluto rivelare i nomi degli hooligans ed inoltre gli olandesi non pagheranno per il danno commesso.

Se al completo, l'assemblea che elegge il Presidente è composta da: 630 deputati, 315 senatori, i senatori a vita che ora sono 6 e i 58 delegati regionali. L'aula in cui si vota è la Camera dei Deputati a palazzo Montecitorio. L'elezione avviene a scrutinio segreto: votano prima i senatori, poi i deputati e per ultimi i delegati regionali. Lo spoglio delle schede lo fa il Presidente della Camera, che elegge ad alta voce i nomi dei candidati. Il presidente della Repubblica rimane in carica per 7 anni e risiede al Palazzo del Quirinale. Secondo l'articolo 84 della Costituzione può diventare capo dello stato "ogni cittadino che abbia compiuto cinquanta anni d'età e goda dei diritti civili e politici". Nessuna donna è stata mai eletta presidente della Repubblica. Nel caso in cui il Presidente della Repubblica non possa adempiere le sue funzioni, sono esercitate dal presidente del Senato.

Gli ex presidenti della Repubblica sono presidenti emeriti e senatori a vita. Sergio Mattarella è succeduto a Giorgio Napolitano che per motivi di età, ha dovuto dare le dimissioni nel suo secondo mandato ed è il nostro 12° Presidente della Repubblica. Impegnato già in politica, nel 1980 dovette affrontare un terribile lutto: suo fratello fu ucciso in un agguato mafioso. In seguito all'assassinio del fratello aumentò progressivamente il suo impegno politico.

Meeting prof. C. Santulli

Professor Carlo Santulli is a University professor, expert in biomimetics, who works in the university with students reading industrial design in Ascoli Piceno. On 14th February he came in our school to tell us with the support of the electronic blackboard (LIM) the way in which plants and nature can give ideas to humans in order to progress in technology and improve our life. We were told for example of a gentleman, Georges De Mestral, who was walking with his dog. The burrs of a plant, the great burdock, got stuck to the dog's hair and gave him the idea of Velcro. At the end, we performed an experiment with a wooden board that was covered with a protecting layer inspired to the lotus leaf and therefore did not get wet with water.

The Open Day

A day of celebration in which primary school children welcomed their fellow kindergarten

It consists of a wooden case in which the printed sheets are placed in front and behind: on the one hand there is the picture and on the other one the text. The viewer sees the image while the narrator reads the story.

The story was about Swimmy, a fish different from the others because he was black, while the others were red. But a bad day tuna ate his family and he was alone. When he met another family of goldfish like him, convinced them to do something to scare tuna: to swim all close to form a giant fish. And so the tuna were frightened.

Children 5 years really enjoyed the story and they said that next year will attend San Liberato primary school.

Saint Valentine, the Saint of love

Everyone in the world celebrate Valentine's Day, but maybe not everyone knows that ... Valentine is the Patron Saint of Terni



February 14th Italians and all other no-Italians celebrate Valentine's Day, the Patron Saint of lovers. Perhaps not everybody knows that St. Valentine was the bishop of Terni in the 2nd century AD.

In fact, Valentine was born in Terni around 175 AD and he became the first bishop of the city in 197 AD for the investiture of Pope Feliciano.

Valentine was martyred on February 14th 273 AD.

For the tradition Valentine is the Patron Saint of lovers or also called "Saint of love".

Why Valentino is associated with protection of lovers it is due to the fact that the Pope Gelasius 1st in 494 would replace the pagan celebration of Lupercalia fertility festival with a similar and Christian one.

Also a legend tells the love story of a Christian girl named Serapia and a pagan centurion named Sabino who with the help of Bishop Valentine (who baptized the boy), persuaded their parents to allow them to be engaged. Then, however, Serapio fell ill with tuberculosis and since Sabino could not live without her, he asked the intervention of Valentino who, raising his hands to the sky, made the two fall asleep in an eternal sleep.

Today Italians celebrate Valentine giving flowers, chocolates and exchanging love cards.

In Terni there is a Basilica with the relics of the Saint and nearby San Valentino is represented with a statue surrounded by many flowers.

Our twelfth President of the Republic

After the resignation of Giorgio Napolitano, Sergio Mattarella is our new President of the Republic

Since February 3rd Sergio Mattarella is officially the President of the Italian Republic. In Italy, the President of the Republic is elected by Parliament in joint session, that is by the House and Senate gathered. The 58 delegates elected by the regional councils participate, too. If full, the shareholders meeting that elects the President consists of 630 deputies, 315 senators, life senators who are now 6 and 58 regional delegates. The place where they vote is the Chamber of Deputies in Montecitorio palace. The election is by secret ballot: first the senators vote, then the deputies, last the regional delegates. The counting of votes is done by the President of the Chamber, which elects aloud the names of the candidates. The President remains in office for seven years and resides at the Quirinale Palace. According to Article 84 of the Constitution can become President of Republic "any citizen who has attained fifty years of age and enjoys civil and political rights". No woman has ever been elected President of Republic. If the President of Republic cannot perform his functions, they are exercised by the President of the Senate.

Former presidents are presidents emeritus and senators for life. Sergio Mattarella has succeeded Giorgio Napolitano that for reasons of age, had to resign in his second mandate and he is our 12th President.

Already engaged in politics, in 1980 he had to face a terrible grief: his brother was killed in a mafia ambush. After the assassination of his brother, he grew gradually his political commitment.

Michele Ferrero, the inventor of the famous Nutella, died

Last 14th of February Mr Michele Ferrero died, he was 89 years old. He was the inventor of Nutella, and of many other things, famous in all the world under the trademark "Ferrero": chocolates as Rocher, Mon Cheri, the Kinder Surprise chocolate egg ...

Ferrero invented Nutella thanks to the ground cocoa beans. Cocoa is very bitter, but Ferrero had made changes making the cocoa sweeter and good. The first jar of Nutella was released on 20th of April 1964 in Alba. Really, since the 20s, the Ferrero family had in mind the idea of making a cheap chocolate snack to eat with bread, convenient for the workers.

Over time the company Ferrero, beginning in family, expanded. At the end of 2000, Ferrero was ranked as the richest man in Italy and the tenth richest man in the world. The company (and Nutella in particular) are famous worldwide.

The name Nutella comes from t Nut = hazelnut in English and ella = Italian term of endearment

Numa outra versão, a máscara, feita de madeira de amieiro é decorada com chifres e outros apetrechos. Pensa-se que a tradição dos Caretos tenha raízes célticas, de um período pré-romano. Provavelmente está relacionada com a existência dos povos Galaicos (*Gallaeci*) e Brácaros (*Bracari*) na Galiza e no norte de Portugal.

"Os Caretos representam imagens diabólicas e misteriosas que todos os anos desde épocas que se perdem no tempo saem à rua nas festividades carnavalescas de Podence – interrompendo os longos silêncios de cada inverno, como que saindo secretos e imprevisíveis dos recantos de Podence, surgem silvando os Caretos e seus frenéticos chocalhos bem cruzados nas franjas coloridas de grossas mantas."



He is a man who wears a mask with a protruding nose made of leather, brass or wood, painted with bright colors like yellow, red or black. In another version, the mask made of alder wood is decorated with horns and other paraphernalia. It is thought that the tradition of Caretos has Celtic roots, a pre-Roman period. It is probably related to the existence of people Galaicos (Gallaeci) and Brácaros (Bracari) in Galicia and north of Portugal.

"Caretos represent evil and mysterious images that every year since times that are lost in time take to the streets in carnival festivities in Podence – stopping the long silences of each winter, as if coming out of the secret and unpredictable Podence corners, come hissing the Caretos and their frantic rattles and crossed the colored fringed with thick blankets."

And what most all children like more it is that all together we make the typical Andalusian breakfast : bread with oil and ham. It is delicious !!!






FEBRUARY 2015 IN MY REGION ANDALUCÍA

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


March 2015 in my school

Welwyn Garden City is in a county called Hertfordshire, it is approx. 20 miles from London (the capital city of United Kingdom.)


