




Chapter 1 France

Granollers. They must look for more feathers.







MARC AND SOPHIE FOUND A POOR MAN WHO WENT TO THE CHURCH AND THEY FOUND..... A NEST.



There they've heard many birds singing: parrots, sparrows, peacocks, blackbirds, ducks...




They asked to the man that sells seeds to feed the birds if he had seen the peace dove, he answered that he sees thousands of doves everyday but none of them was all white.

children in the world!





window of the school. To be clearer,


they decide to draw a map with the

...Mix bruschettas...





On the schoolbus we enjoy with our new friends and sing a traditional song.




We arrive to Ripalimosani.







Ripalimosani is a small village near Campobasso; Campobasso is the main town in Molise. Molise is one of the 20 Italian regions.






This is the coat of arms of our village

the year 1000




San Michele Square




The Croceviaria was built in 1562. It is high more than three metres.





This is the fountain Irma. It was forged in Paris in 1900. In ancient times the women came here to take the water.



This is Saint Maria Assunta church, built in 1500. The beautiful bell tower is high 47 metres and it was built in 1463.



The Holy Shroud's copy, revered in the S. Maria Assunta, is a very rare historical document. The Duke, Carlo Emanuele of Savoia, gave it to his father-in-law, King of Spain, Phillip II, in 1594.



This is the organ inside the church



Marc and Sophie go to the Palazzo Marchesale. They hope to see the dove of peace here. They look for the feather in the beautiful rooms, but they don't find it.

The palazzo marchesale was built around the year 1000. The local lords lived here. There was also a jail called " cafurchio" without light.







This is the courtyard






This is an inside room.




It's late! We go to bed.




It's seven o'clock, Marc and Sophie get up. They are ready to have a typical breakfast: milk, "pastarelle", "pepatelli".









It's a quarter past eight, it's school time. Marc and Sophie come to school with us.




We teach to Marc and Sophie to say "ciao", "grazie", "mi chiamo".





We show them our school and we study English together. We enjoy a lot!



After lunch, on foot we reach the Convento, an ancient building where there are a church, a library, a big garden and an institute for children. Marc and Sophie don't find the feather yet.





It's Nicola birthday! He is 100 years old. We are at the party. Suddenly we see the feather in the pocket of Nicola's jacket. What a surprise!!








Before leaving the hospice Marc and Sophie want to take some photos with Nicola.








This is a furnicular in the centre of Zagreb. Let's go for a ride! Can you hear a roar? Look, Sophie a ZOO!







When Marc and Sophie arrived to Varaždin,Croatia, they immediately started looking through city streets and squares.








The hatter and the weavers told them to find the Grgur Ninski statue that holds something in his hand. Maybe it's the dove.



If you touch his thumb maybe we'll get lucky in our search.










They were already very tired of the search when they saw that the sun clock on the cathedral is showing a snack time.



Then they took the tour bus and had a tour around the city.




They saw the statue of Alexander the Great,




The orthodox church of Panagia Dexia

the Archaeological and Byzantine Museums






From the City Hall they rent a bike to go for a ride by the sea.

They decided to visit the Castles and the White Tower.


They rode on the tour bus again and start touring towards the Castles and the Old city


towards the top of the Tower.




Sophie already feels hungry so they stop for a "koulouri" or a sweet "bougatsa".




"Thessaloniki is a real crossword of civilizations"




Marc and Sophie arrive at Piraeus, the port of Athens. Loukas and Athéna, their Greek friends meet them there. They speak english but they also speak french.








Having seen a pigeon's feather land on the picture of the Clandras Bridge, they head in that direction.

This statue was made of bronze in 1633. At the same time it is a fountain. It presents the king of sea. It is a favourite meeting place for tourists.






The sweetest surprise for Marc and Sophie is the visit in a sweets factory named 'Ciuciu', which is on Long Street. They make all the sweets by hands there.

Its area is 136 hectares big and located on the edge of Trojmiejski Park. It started to work in 1954.


In the zoo there are animals from all continents. Here we can watch the species which don't exist in wildlife any more like antelope Bongo. There are more than thousand animals.

In order to have a little rest walking, they go to the space 3D cinema, named Planétarium, They spend some time dreaming of stars, feeling very tiny in that infinite world...


